



WIDFORD LODGE PREPARATORY SCHOOL SCHOOL FEES

Pre-School

The fees include a mid-morning and mid-afternoon snack and drink. A cooked meal is provided at midday for all those children who are on full days.

Lunchtime cost of £5.26 is included in the above fee.

Reception, Pre-Prep and Preparatory School Fees

For those seeking entry straight into the Reception, Pre-Prep or Preparatory school there will be a non-refundable £180 (£150+VAT) registration fee.

Reception and Pre-Prep (Reception, Years 1 and 2)	Fees of £3,230.94 plus VAT of £646.19 per term. Lunches and stationery non-Vatable £235.87. Total per term: £4,113
Preparatory School	Fees of £3,760.15 plus VAT of £752.03 per term. Lunches and stationery non-Vatable £270.82. Total per term: £4,783

In order to enrol your child, you need to complete a registration form and pay a non-refundable fee of £180 (£150+VAT). If you choose to register your child for Reception at the same time as Pre-School, only one registration fee of £150 plus £30 is payable. Pre School fees are not subject to VAT.

School fees are payable on or before the first day of each term. A term's fee is payable in advance in the Easter term prior to starting Reception, to secure a place. Late payment of subsequent fees may attract interest of up to 2% accruing daily.

Fees are charged termly. There will be no refund for any absence, however parents may choose to take out Optional School Fee Protection insurance which is detailed on the fees bill.

15 Hours Funded Early Education Entitlement

Your child will receive 15 hours per week of Funded Early Education Entitlement during their time in Pre-School and Reception, from the term after they turn 3 and up to and including the term in which they have their 5th birthday. This will be reflected in your school fee invoice. A registration fee is not required if you will only use the 15 hours weekly funded universal childcare for 3- and 4-year-olds.

One term's written notice of withdrawal is required. Such notice must be given no later than the last day of term preceding the term at the end of which the pupil is to leave. i.e one full term plus the preceding holiday.

In default of such notice, the fees for the following term will be charged. The school reserves the right to pass on information about unpaid accounts to a new school if the fees have not been settled. A parent's signature on the registration form confirms acceptance of these conditions.

All EYFS Late Stay provision must be pre-booked in advance. From September 2026 Payment for Late Stay will be via the Parent Pay app.

Breakfast Club

Pupils in Reception to Year 6 may attend breakfast club between 7.30am and 8am at a cost of £5 per session. These sessions **must** be prebooked and paid for via the Parent Pay app (from September 2026) by 12noon the previous day. A selection of cereals, fruit, toast and yoghurts are available at breakfast club.

Music

All individual musical instrument lessons are charged at a rate of £22 per half-hour, which is normally a weekly lesson.

Instruments offered; piano, violin, cello, flute, oboe, clarinet, guitar, recorder, voice and theory of music are available on an individual basis.

Speech & Drama Individual, pair or group (max 5 children) sessions

Individual: £22 per half-hour session

Pair: £15 per child

Group £12 per child

For music and speech & drama lessons, a term's fees are payable in advance, and are charged at a minimum of ten lessons; but in some terms it will be possible to give eleven or twelve lessons. A term's notice (ten lessons) is required for the termination of lessons.
